Grad Night is a parent-sponsored event. This is a drug-free and alcohol-free celebration to be held at Centre Concord - 5298 Clayton Road, Concord, Ca. Requirements to attend this event for 2019 graduates are listed below.

The graduate must:

1. Purchase an Non-Refundable Electronic Ticket via the school webstore. (Note: There is no *physical* ticket.)
 2. Submit TWO completed permission slips (1. CVCHS and 2. Centre Concord). See above for options on how to return signed forms.
 3. Join the **Grad Night Remind Account**. Do this by texting **@CV19gradn** to the number **81010**. (This is important for communication purposes.)
 4. Be a Clayton Valley High School Graduate and in Good Standing.
 5. Arrive to Centre Concord between 10:00 pm and 11:00 pm. Gates close at 11:00. Parents will be notified if their student has not arrived by 11:00 pm.
 6. Present an ID to get into the event (e.g., CV Student Body ID card or California ID/Driver's License).
 7. Adhere to the rules regarding personal belongings. Grad Night is not responsible for any lost/stolen items. Leave valuables/money at home. Any personal items that are brought to the event such as wallets, purses, etc. will be searched and **MUST** be checked in at the door. These items will be placed in a bag assigned to each graduate and that bag will remain in a protected "coat-room" with parent monitors. Items that graduates **WILL** be able to keep with them during the event are: phone/camera, spare battery, and a jacket/sweatshirt (recommended for outdoor games). ****Comfortable footwear is highly recommended, including socks for bowling.**
- Basic OTC medicine (specifically: ibuprofen, tylenol, and benadryl dispensed after a parent/guardian phone call), and feminine products will be provided. Do **NOT** bring any of these items. If a specific medicine is required, please indicate this on Page 2. If a specific feminine product is needed, please send a confidential email to: cvchs2019senioractivities@gmail.com.
8. Graduates are strongly encouraged to remain at grad night until the end of the hypnotist/comedy show at 4:45 am. If a graduate requests to leave before 4:45 am, they will need to be picked up by a guardian over the age of 25. Further, the guardian must physically check in with security prior to the release of the graduate. This is for their safety and we will not waiver on this policy.
 9. Any Graduate who leaves early will not be allowed to return to the event.
 10. Attendees **MUST** leave all decorations as found. Nothing is to be removed or destroyed as other schools are also using Centre Concord for their Grad Nights.
 11. Signing this permission slip authorizes the release of candid photos of the event and its participants.
 12. All graduates will be required to pass a pat-down prior to admission. If alcohol or drugs are found, the substance will be confiscated and the parent/guardian will be notified immediately to come pick up the graduate. The graduate will not be allowed to attend the event - no exceptions, no refunds.
 13. All graduates will be required to pass a breathalyzer screening. If a test shows ANY level of alcohol above 0.0, they will be given a second test. If the second test shows that there is ANY level of alcohol above 0.0, a parent/guardian will be notified to come pick up the graduate. There will be no wait time between tests, nor will the graduate be allowed into the event at any point later in the evening. There will be no exceptions and no refunds. **This is a zero-tolerance event.**

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT

I, _____ the parent/guardian of _____ (“the minor”), for myself and on behalf of the minor:

1. Consent to the minor’s participation in the City of Concord’s Grad Nite Event (hereinafter “Event”), which shall take place on June 5 - 6, 2019 at the City of Concord’s Centre Concord facility. The Event may include a dance, casino-style games, a health spa, videos, and the serving of food and beverages. While the Event is conducted at a City owned facility, it is neither sponsored nor supervised by the City;

2. Acknowledged that the minor and I fully understand that although one or more representatives of the City of Concord (hereinafter “City”) may be present at the Event (in a non-supervising capacity), and although the event will be supervised and attended by the parents of certain participants, serious accidents can and occasionally do occur during activities such as the Event. As such, the minor’s participation may involve risk of serious injury or death, including economic losses, which may result not only from the minor’s own actions, omissions, and negligence, but also from the actions, omissions, and negligence of others, the condition of the facilities equipment, or areas where the event or activity is being conducted, the rules of play, or this type of event or activity;

3. Assume any and all risks of personal injuries to the minor, and release, waive, discharge, and relinquish the City, its officers, agents, employees, volunteers and from any and all claims, liens, damages, lawsuits, or liability for property damage, injury or death, resulting from, arising out of, or in any way connected with the minor’s participation in the Event. I agree and acknowledge that this Release and Waiver of Liability/Assumption of Risk shall apply even in the even that negligent acts or omissions (other than sole, active negligence) on the part of the City, its officers, agents, employees, or volunteers may have caused or contributed to the death, injury or property damage;

4. Authorize the City to contact or employ a licensed physician to render any medical treatment that may be deemed necessary for the minor or to take and admit the minor to any hospital. If such medical treatment or hospitalization is required, I agree to pay all medical and hospital bills relating thereto, permanent or partial disability, or death and damages to the minor’s or my property caused by or arising from the minor’s participation in the event or activity;

5. Agree that photographs, pictures, slides, movies, or videos of the minor may be taken in connection with the minor’s participation in the Event without compensation from the City, and consent to the use of photographs, pictures, slides, movies or videos for any legal purpose;

6. Warrant that the minor has no physical condition that would prevent him/her from participation in the Event.

NOTICE: Each student will be subject to a pat down search and Breathalyzer test, before entering the event.

I HAVE READ THIS WAIVER AND RELEASE IN ITS ENTIRETY. I FULLY UNDERSTAND IT, AND RECOGNIZE THAT THIS WAIVER AND RELEASE IS A LEGALLY BINDING DOCUMENT. I UNDERSTAND THAT BY EXECUTING THIS WAIVER AND RELEASE, I AM VOLUNTARILY ASSUMING THE RISKS DESCRIBED HEREIN, AND WAIVING MY LEGAL RIGHTS ASSOCIATED THEREWITH, AND/OR THE RIGHTS OF THE MINOR ON WHOSE BEHALF THIS DOCUMENT IS EXECUTED.
