Grad Night: June 5 - 6
Important Information for Attendees and Parents/Guardians

What time should we arrive?

- Check in is from 10:00 - 11:00 pm.
- Anyone who arrives after 11:00 will not be allowed into Grad Night (and no refunds will be given).
- Parents/guardians of any “no-shows” will be contacted

Pro Tip: We ask that you do NOT drive yourselves to Grad Night as parking will be tight and most spots are reserved for volunteers. Please try to get a ride from a parent/guardian/older sibling, etc., and carpool when possible to help with traffic in the parking lot. You will be VERY TIRED at 5:00 am and therefore will not be in the best shape to drive. Please take this request seriously and arrange to get dropped off and picked up.

What should we bring?

- Student body ID card (recommended) or driver’s license
- Warm jacket/sweatshirt
- Socks for Bowling and Inflatable Games
- Cell Phone

Pro Tip: Bring a portable battery charger and cord for your phone if you have one! There will be an area to charge your phones but it’s **very limited** with just a few outlets. (You will also need to bring your own cords and cubes if you want to use these outlets. (Note: Volunteers cannot guard your phones for you).

Pro Tip: Try to charge your phone as much as you can before coming to graduation and put your phones in “low power” mode to extend battery life.

What should we NOT bring?

- Money, Wallets, Purses, Backpacks
- Medicines (unless already approved by the nurse), feminine supplies (these will be provided)
- Gum, Mints (these will be provided), Deodorant, Perfumes/Body Sprays, Tobacco Products, etc.
- Hair Brushes, Make-Up, etc.

Insider Info: If you absolutely must bring a purse or backpack, etc., it will be searched thoroughly and kept in a bag in the coat room with parent monitors during the entire event. You will not be permitted to keep the items with you.

But what if we need medicine for a headache or something?

- The nurse will have ibuprofen, tylenol, benadryl, an epi-pen, and standard first-aid items. Just go to the lobby and ask the Parent Volunteer to contact the Nurse for assistance.

What about food?

- Come Hungry!!!! We have a full dinner planned from 10:00 - Midnight. This will be followed by desserts, a nacho bar, pizza, etc. to get you through the night. Finally, Dunkin Donuts, bagels, and fruit will be available at 3:00 am for a very early breakfast.

What will security be like?

→ At check-in, you will go through a pat search, be breathalyzed, and all items will be examined (this is why we ask that you only bring the essential items we list above).

→ Grad Night is a ZERO-TOLERANCE event with regard to alcohol and drugs. If any graduate fails the first, and then the second breathalyzer test, they will be sent home with a parent/guardian. Any detection by the breathalyzers beyond 0.0 will result in being turned away. Further, no time will be given for a student to metabolize the alcohol and then allowed into the event. The moment the student enters the line at check-in, they are expected to be 100% sober (0.0 on a breathalyzer). Moreover, if a student is suspected of being under the influence of drugs, we also reserve the right to send them home with their parent/guardian.

→ Anybody turned away for the reasons above, will NOT be reimbursed for their ticket.

Pro Tip: Do not take even a “sip” of alcohol at any point in time on June 5. Even small amounts can be detected by the breathalyzer and you will lose your opportunity to enjoy an awesome event. Further, do not come to the event under the influence of drugs, including marijuana. If we suspect you have something in your system, we will send you home with a parent/guardian. Come SOBER and ready to have a blast in a healthy and positive way!

Can I leave Centre Concord before 5:00 am?

→ We do not recommend that graduates leave early because we’ve saved the best for last! The hypnotist will start his show around 3:45 and it’s going to be a blast! However, if you are feeling sick and just aren’t able to stay for the whole night, we require that a parent or guardian picks you up. This person must check in with security first, prior to your “release”. Our primary concern is your safety - therefore no exceptions to this rule will be allowed.

Will there be awesome prizes to possibly win?

→ Yes! There will be TWO rounds of drawings at 12:30 and 2:30. Keep your eye out for the things you can win at two separate times!

→ You MUST be present to win. We will post the winner on a “raffle board” and also on the Grad Night Remind account.

→ Be sure to write your **Grad Night Lanyard Number** on every ticket before putting them in raffle box.

→ We will keep the prizes for you until check-out.

Pro Tip: Be sure to write your **Grad Night Lanyard Number** on your ticket. We won’t have any other way of knowing who the winner is unless you write your number on the ticket!

Pro Tip: Remember that there are two raffles. Think strategically about how and when you want to spend and earn your tickets! There will be a list of the items for each raffle in the raffle area.

Pro Tip: Join the Remind Account by texting @cv19gradn to 81010 because this is how you’ll know if you won. (We will also post winners’ names on a board in the raffle area.)

Anything else we need to know?

→ It is **required** that you join the Remind Group Text for tonight by texting @cv19gradn to 81010.

→ **DRESS COMFORTABLY.** This will be an ACTIVE night so wear comfy clothes. Wear socks (or bring them) and don’t forget a jacket as it will get cold late at night and we have lots of fun things going on outside.
